How to take 12 photos that will help to sell your fire truck:

- Take photos outside of the station
- Try to keep the sun at your back (you might have to move the truck once)

Handy photo checklist:

- 1.Driver side: whole truck in the photo
- 2.Driver side: wide with all compartments open whole truck in the photo
- 3. Passenger side: whole truck in the photo
- 4.Passenger side: with all compartment open whole truck in the photo
- 5.Beauty shot front of truck
- 6.Beauty shot rear of truck
- 7. Rear shot: wide with rear compartment open (if applicable)
- 8.Interior seating front
- 9.Interior seating rear of cab (if applicable)
- 10.11. 12: Any special features or flaws (ie, inside of walk-in rescue or ambulance, specialized equipment included, close up aerial bucket, or certain areas of concern such as rust).
